Dom des Clos, Beaune `Vieilles Vignes 1926` 2012

Noticeably dark purple colour. Concentration from the old vines, perhaps. Dense black cherry fruit, moderate oak and a savoury finish with semi-firm tannins – drinkable now, but with a dryness that invites ageing. Perhaps a bit austere – yet the concentration and deep colour seems modernist. An interesting juxtaposition!

Quite restrained fruit. Firm but fine tannic structure. Good persistence. Rather unassuming now but seems to have the concentration to last well.
